Drop-off and Pick-up:

Drop-off

At the Sports Complex with your child, you must accompany your child and leave him or her in the care of a staff member. If you have any questions, someone at the reception desk will direct you and answer all questions.

Extended Supervision Hours (ESH)

If you need to drop off your child early to camp or pick him or her up later, we are pleased to offer an Extended Supervision Hours service included within the March Break programs. ESH is from 7:00 am to 8:45 am in the mornings and from 4:15 pm to 6:00 pm in the afternoons. ESH will take place in Vanier College's Sports Complex.

Pick-up

Once you have completed the online registration process, you will be prompted to choose a password. Please know that you will need it to pick up your child at the end of each day. In order to leave with your child, you must give the password to the staff member in charge. If you intend to have anyone else pick up your child, it is your responsibility to inform them of your password. In the event that a person forgets the password, they will be directed to the reception where a member of our team will verify their identity. **Under no circumstances will a child be allowed to leave if the above criteria are not met.**

VERY IMPORTANT: Daily activities will not be taking place on the Vanier College campus. Therefore, it is especially important to arrive and pick up your child on time. There will be no additional activities planned in case of late arrival.
